



CAIRNS RSL CLUB

BY – LAWS

1. All members and their guests are requested to regard their Club with pride and assist in every possible manner in the direction of dress, conduct, decorum.
2. Members and their guests will not be permitted in or allowed to remain on the Club premises unless cleanly and properly dressed in strict accordance with the following:
 - 2.1 The minimum dress requirements for men are shorts, acceptable shirt (no singlets) and footwear. Women must be decently clothed and footwear worn at all times. Clothing that is deemed to be obscene and offensive is not permitted at any time.
 - 2.2 Work apparel will only be allowed in the sports bar.
 - 2.3 Hats and caps or any form of headwear is not permitted to be worn by patrons in any part of the club unless for genuine ethnic-religious reasons.
3. The General Manager or his representative has the authority to vary or stipulate change to dress regulations for specific occasions in all or part of the club premises.
4. The General Manager or his representative will be the final arbitrator in all dress related matters.
5. During bistro trading hours the seating in the Bistro is reserved for Bistro patrons only.
6. The carriage and consumption of drinks in the entry foyer is not permitted.
 - 6.1 No food is to be brought onto Club premises unless by prior arrangement with the General Manager.
7. Bottled liquor must not be taken off Club premises outside of hours by Liquor laws, even though the same may have been purchased before then. Liquor must not be brought into in the Club premises at any time.
8. Subscriptions shall be payable, and in the case of new members shall be lodged with the application for membership. The fees shall be determined from time to time by the committee.
9. Applicants that have been rejected for membership or any member who has been expelled or is under suspension shall not be permitted as a temporary member or guest.
10. A member may introduce the following: wife, husband, or friends as guests provided that they ensure that their guests are registered in the guests of member register and that they remain in their reasonable company throughout the length of their stay in the Club. A guest

must not remain on the Club premises any longer than the member who introduced the guests.

10.1 Members must carry on their person and be prepared to show their membership card when entering or on the Club premises.

11. No person whose usual place of residence is within a 15-kilometre radius from the Club will be admitted as a temporary member.

11.1 All persons who are not members must produce identification identifying their place of residence.

12. Patrons are requested to leave the bar promptly after being served.

13. Smoking is only permitted in designated areas that comply with the smoking ACT.

13.1 Smoking is not permitted at any function held on the Club premises unless that has been designated accordingly.

13.2 Patrons who remove food from a designated non-smoking area i.e. the Bistro, for any reason whatsoever, for consumption in an area where smoking is allowed acknowledge that they do so at their own discretion and by personal choice.

14. Raffles, sales of goods and sweeps will not be permitted on Club premises unless authorized by the General Manager.

15. The Club staff or any Board member is vested with discretionary authority to cease serving with liquor any member or guest, who in their opinion is misconduct, creating a nuisance, incident, violent, quarrelsome or is deemed to be in a state of intoxication, until the closing time of the Club.

15.1 The Club has in place a Responsible Service of Alcohol Policy which shall be adhered to at all times.

16. "No Persons wearing any form of jewellery or other accessories displaying or indicating by form of wording, colours, logo, symbol other otherwise that they are members or are in any way associated with Outlaw Motor Cycle Groups will not be allowed or permitted to remain on Club premises.

17. The Duty Manager(s) or Duty Supervisor(s) will have the power and endorsement of the Board to remove or eject any member or guest who does not abide by or comply with the Club rules, By Lays, Constitution and Liquor ACT.

18. The Club has in place a policy which complies with Responsible Gambling Legislation, including a Self-Exclusion Scheme. Details of which can be obtained from the office.

19. The General Manager, Duty Manager(s), Duty Supervisor(s) or the Club President will have the power and endorsement of the Board to suspend a member for misbehaviour for a period of up to one month.
